- Catholic Stewardship Consultants report update was distributed.

- Finance Council

 - Considering refinancing loan, getting offered lower interest rate, could save \$30k in interest over four years.

 - Considering collaborating with Worship Commission on utilization of gathering space.
 - Reviewing CMA distribution/ Tithing allocations. St. Raphael's will be January tithing beneficiary.
 - Considering exit quotes.
- Parish Life/ Stewardship Commission
 - o Considering approach for volunteer thank you event.
 - o Fashion show may be resurrected.
 - \circ Chili cook off is November 10th. Will tie in with Welcome Weekend.
 - o Play tickets will include appetizers.
 - o Fellowship Weekend program is one year old.
 - o Will be rotating PC meeting attendance.
 - Upcoming parish life survey, scheduled for next fall. Possibly bottom up? What talents do you have, and how can we leverage them in our community?
- Evangelization/ Catechesis Commission
 - o Still in formation.
 - o Reviewing member qualifications, basing on servitude attributes.
