- Reviewing options for volunteer appreciation. Acting recording secretary only true PC volunteer. Committees have more volunteers. Each committee is reviewing options.
- Ministry of the Week assessing possibility. Would have hosted snacks weekly, highlighting ministries. Cost impact, but may be strategic investment. PC members should send MariBeth feedback.
- Considering use of prayer partners to streamline cross-ministry/ staff, etc. Send feedback to MariBeth.
- Catholic Schools Committee appears to be parish interest. May be fit for Evangelism/ Catechesis. Christy Burke possible moderator. Fr. Geoff to reach out to appropriate individuals.
- Church Booklet Considering component of welcome packet that will include expectations of parishioners. Could be tool for new families. Will consider leveraging Catholic Stewardship Consultants.
