Gospel...Matthew 22:1-14...The Wedding Feast

An adaption of the Sunday Gospel.

Jesus: Listen to a parable about what God's Kingdom is like. Once there was a king whose son was getting married. The king decided to have a big wedding feast.

King: Messengers, go tell the people I invited that the feast is ready.

Messengers: Come and celebrate! Come to the king's wedding feast for his son.

Shopkeeper: I am too busy.

Farmer: Who will do my work if I go to the feast?

Others: Don't bother us. We are not interested.

Messengers: King, we went to the people you invited, but no one will come.

King: The feast is ready. Go, invite everyone you see.

Jesus: The messengers went out and invited all kinds of people. They all came to the feast for the king's son and his bride.

Gospel Reflection Questions (not required, but could help with discussion...just a summary is fine)

1. Why does the king invite new guests?
2. How is God like the king?
3. To what great feast does Jesus invite us?
