Neighborhood Rep (NR) Role:

1. Make initial contact with neighbors on list.
2. Ask if you can have email address and if you can share it with MOC.
3. Our goal is to build a sense of community- recommend making quarterly contact.
4. Contact new neighbors in neighborhood.

Area Coordinator (AC) Role

1. Do the NR Role for your NR's.
2. Send "change" info to appropriate NR i.e. adds, deletes, deaths, Baptisms, etc.
3. Seek Neighborhood Reps

Confidentiality

1. Always ask if you can share status with others in the neighborhood as well as can we name the person in the prayers for the sick.
2. Respect the wishes of the neighbor.
3. Do not impose your beliefs.

When you have a situation where you will be supporting a neighbor- Find Out:

1. Can we let other people know the situation?
2. What specifics can we share about the situation?
3. Would you like meals during this time of need?
4. Is there something else your neighbors can do? i.e. Prayers?

How will you know someone has a need?

1. The neighbor will call you as the Neighborhood Rep.
2. The neighbor will call the Parish Office then the information will be shared with you by your Region Coordinator or Area Coordinator.

How will you communicate back to the Parish Office?

1. Let your AC (or RC if no AC) know. They will share back with the office so that Father knows the status.
2. If the person would like to have their name mentioned at Mass, it is best if they are willing to call Kathy in the office. Otherwise VERIFY directly that the person is OK with sharing.
