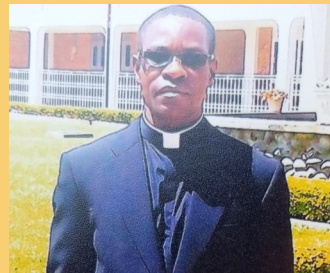

Holy Angels Student Education Scholarship



Holy Angels College is a school of 250 students from grades 8-11. The school is less expensive than Ugandan schools and 50% of the students are catechist's children. Past St. Max contributions have completed boys and girls dormitories, water for drinking and bathing, and a science lab and library, which have helped the school meet the Ugandan education standards to remain in business. Our goal is to support 50 students from St. Patrick's Church throughout their education at this level.

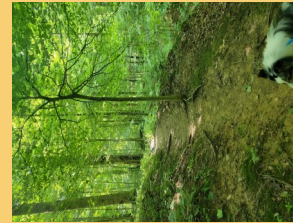
School History

Holy Angels was established in 1945 as a junior school within Madera Catholic Mission. Unfortunately in the early 1970s during the government of Idi Amin the Mill Hill missionaries who were the founders were expelled from the country and the school collapsed. However with the creation of Soroti as a diocese in 1981, there was a need for the minor seminary, to create a seed bed for forming future priests in the Diocese of Soroti. Holy Angels structures were turned into a formation house for the Diocesan priests in Soroti Catholic Diocese.

Later in 2004, the idea of reviving Holy Angels College was introduced by Fr. Richard Pius Okiria based on the excellent past academic reputation of the school. This idea was embraced by most of the clergy in the Diocese and some of the former boys of Holy Angels. Good enough Holy Angels College old boys association was formed in 2006 as a major force behind reviving the past glory of Holy Angels College and setting it into a model school in Teso sub-region.

In 2010-2014, the education commission of Soroti Catholic Diocese, together with the Old boys association, lobbied for some funds in the Netherlands and managed to build a four-class room block with some offices.

This was guided by then parish priest and pastor of St. Patrick's, Fr. Simon Peter Wankya.



In 2015 Holy Angels College was re-opened as an O-level mixed school (grade 8-11) junior high school with Mr. Stephen Kitembo being its first head teacher with an enrollment of 23 students in the whole school. From 2016-2019 a number of initiatives took place through Fr. Simon Peter Wankya and the partnership with St. Maximilian Kolbe Parish, two dormitories; one for the girls and one for the boys and a science laboratory were built. Water harvesting tanks were also put in place along side the well here at the school.

All this has been made possible due to God's love for us, but more specifically due to your kind and generous hearts of helping us, the people of St. Patrick's Parish.
